

HHSC October 4, 2021 Important Information:



(This form is subject to change, monitor emails closely!)

- 1. All HHSC policies & procedures must be followed at **ALL TIMES**. (Available on our website). Everyone **MUST** practice social distancing whenever possible. Please ensure all skaters are aware of proper hand hygiene. How to Handwash (available on our website)
- 2. All skaters, coaches, and volunteer's (not on skater form as guardian) MUST hand in a signed copy of the Skate Canada Assumption of Risk and Waiver form. HHSC Assumption of Risk and Waiver (also available on our website) This form needs to be handed in ONCE for the season, on your first skating day at check-in or email copy! Guardians must have printed and signed skater form to be able to assist a skater (when allowed) (max 4 guardians). If guardian is at a different address than the skater, please include the address on page 3.
- 3. Numbers are limited depending on facility and restrictions. Persons include skaters, coaches, volunteers, and spectators. Spectators (parents/guardians/siblings/etc) are permitted in the arena at this time for all sessions (1 spectator per skater ONLY!) Spectators must remain at their designated spot, this will be communicated at check-in. All spectators will enter/exit the facility with the skater. No wondering around the facility or congregating in common areas (lobby, dressing rooms, etc). All spectators must have signature on skaters Assumption of Risk and Waiver or hand in a new one. Monitor emails for this could be subject to change. DO NOT OPT OUT of receiving emails. Please confirm this on your account.
- 4. Each skater (or parent/guardian), coach, and volunteer (anyone entering building) MUST review the Health Screening Questionnaire Health Screening Questionnaire (also available on our website). The form MUST be reviewed DAILY at home 1-hour prior to arrival at the arena. A verbal confirmation will be required prior to entry of the facility DAILY. If you answer YES to any of the questions, please STAY HOME! Immediately contact your head coach and HHSC at admin@hhskatingclub.com. Contact Alberta Health at 811, if needed.
- 5. Everyone 12 years old and older must have Proof of Vaccination and ID to enter the facilities. Please review the Mandatory Restrictions form Mandatory Restrictions Sep 20 & 23 (also available on our website). You will be turned away without the proper Proof of Vaccination and ID. For those parents not able to enter the facility have skaters dressed and ready to skate and they will be brought in at check-in. Remain close to the entry doors just in case you are needed.
- 6. <u>Items Needed:</u> Pre-Can/CanSkate/Pre-Power/IntroFS/Teen-Adult: skates (sharpened), Hard guards (walking on cement), CSA certified hockey helmet (no bike, ski), gloves and warm skating attire. StarSkate: skates (sharpened), hard guards, gloves & all skating attire, water bottle (filled at home).
- 7. Masks are **MANDATORY** for entry & exit, and washroom breaks (all public areas). **Spectators MUST** wear their masks at ALL TIMES. Skaters are not required to wear a mask while on the ice.
- 8. Entry/Exit (Check-ins with coach): **HH Arena** Entry/exit at the main (South) doors, go to arena lobby upstairs. **VIVO Arena** Entry/exit at the East (Arena) Doors. **Check-in will be 15-10 minutes prior to your session start time. PLEASE do not arrive late**, all coaches are needed on the ice and cannot remain at check-in area.
